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## World's Simplest Mittens

Level: Advanced Beginner

Learn to work the Magic Loop technique in the round with this simple mitten pattern. This class will help you get comfortable using magic loop, increasing, and decreasing.

## Continental Knitting

Level: Advanced beginner

Learn to knit faster while placing less strain on your elbows, wrists and shoulders. You will learn the continental or "picking" method to knit, purl, increase and decrease.

Knitted Knockers are special handmade breast prosthesis for women who have undergone mastectomies or other procedures to the breast. Learn how to help the local community with these soft, comfortable prostheses. More info online.

This 3-part class will double as an intro to sock knitting, without the second-sock syndrome! You will learn all of the techniques needed to make your first pair of socks. You will learn to work in the round with double pointed needles, working a heel flap, and using Kitchener Stitch to finish a toe.

Learn two-handed stranded color work to create your first Fair Isle project. You will learn best practices for color work, and following a chart.
